



Overview

QLIK IHDR interactive reports provide access to online reports that allow you to view trends and patterns in your Health Service's data and compare your data with that of other similar Health Services.

When your Health Service submits data assets in the Health Data Portal, the contents of these data assets can be viewed as interactive reports in QLIK. QLIK is accessed through the Data Portal using the *Interactive Report Viewer* role.



To access QLIK, you need to have been given the appropriate role in the Data Portal by a Department of Health System Administrator.

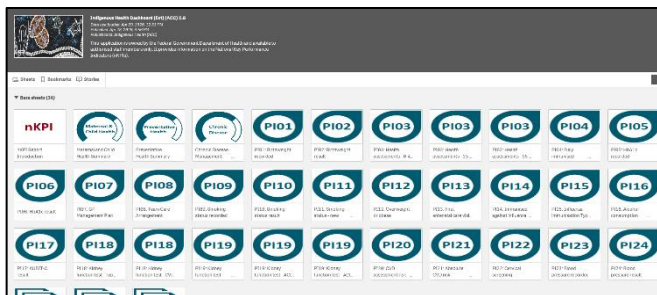
Accessing QLIK IHDR Interactive Reports

To access the QLIK Interactive Reports interface:

1. Navigate to the Data Portal Home screen.
2. To continue, select **Reports > Interactive Reports** on the menu bar.
3. On the left-hand side of the screen that displays, select **Indigenous Health**.
4. On the right-hand side of the screen that displays, select the top half of the **Indigenous Health Dashboard (Ext)** app.

The Indigenous Health Dashboard (Ext) screen will display.

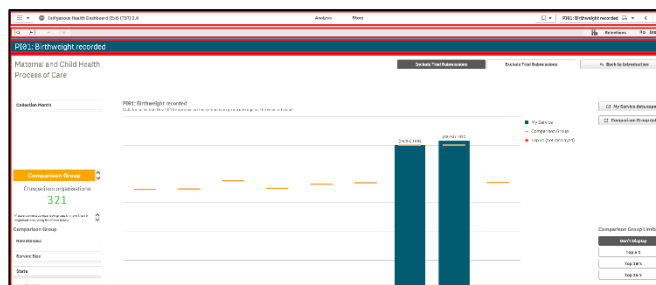
The Indigenous Health Dashboard (Ext) screen



The *Indigenous Health Dashboard (Ext)* screen is the launch screen from where you can access all IHDR summary and individual indicator reports, as well as the *Health Service* and *Comparison Group Data Export* reports.

1. To access a particular report from the *Indigenous Health Dashboard (Ext)* screen, simply select the tile representing the required report.

Getting started with QLIK IHDR Reports



All QLIK IHDR report screens are divided into four sections:

1. The Menu Bar
2. The Selections Bar
3. The Title Bar
4. The Layout View/Main screen window.

The Menu Bar (Top)

The *Menu Bar* enables you to perform the following tasks in QLIK (from left to right):

- Select to access QLIK help or learn more about the software.
- Select to open and close the report header, which displays the title of the report and the last time data was added to the report.
- Select to bookmark and save the location of a particular report, or a filter/comparison group you have created. You can return to the report or filter/comparison group as required later on.
- Select **nKPI Report Introduction** (the name of your report) to open a list of all available QLIK IHDR reports so you can quickly jump to a particular report as/if needed. The name listed on this button will display the report you are currently viewing.
- Select to move forward and back between the IHDR reports.

The Selections Bar (2)

The *Selection Bar*, beneath the Menu Bar, contains the following functions (from left to right):

- Select and enter in key words to search the entirety of your data within the reports.
- Select to move back and forth between the various data filters you have selected.
- Select to clear any filters you have selected.
- When viewing a sheet, if you select various filters, they will group together for your analysis. These filters will display as .
- Select to open up a view containing more filter options for the report. Simply select it again to return to the report.

The Title Bar (3)

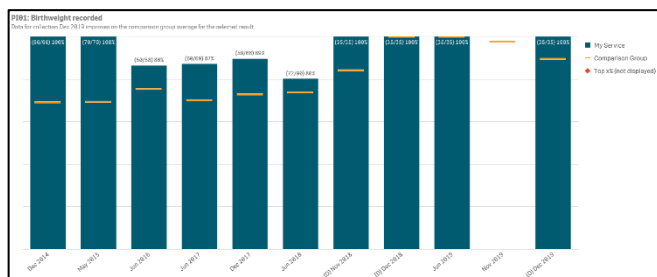
The *Title Bar* contains the name of the report you currently have open (e.g. PI01: Birthweight recorded).

The Layout View/Main screen window (4)

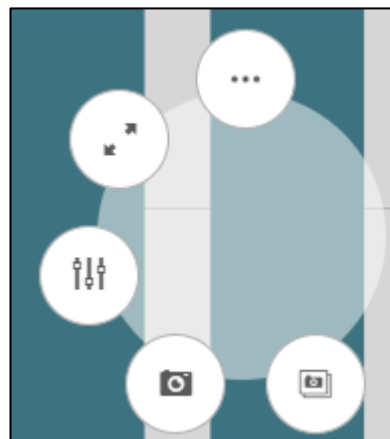
The Layout view/Main screen window of any IHDR report contains the graph or graphs showing your Health Service's results (and those of any comparison groups you have created) for the selected indicator(s).

More IHDR Reports Features

In addition to the four common screen sections discussed earlier, there are other standard functions available from any IHDR report within QLIK.

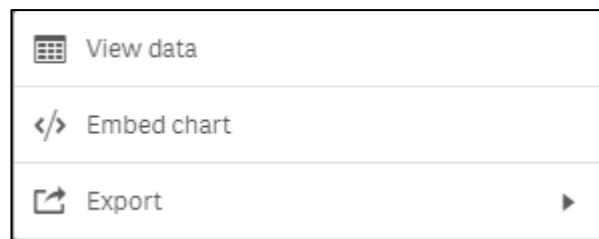


The Shortcut Menu



In addition to the hover menu, the shortcut menu also allows you to perform particular functions with a report. The shortcut menu is activated by right clicking on the selected graph.

- Opens a list of all snapshots you have taken in the report so you can add them to your data presentation if needed.
- Allows you to take a snapshot of the data that can then be used in a presentation you may wish to give about your data. For more information, see *Take Snapshots* in the QLIK Interactive Reports user guide.
- Allows you to quickly change the properties of the results you are viewing without making selections or editing the report. For more information, see *Explore Selections* in the QLIK Interactive Reports user guide.
- Places the report into full screen mode.
- Brings up the following sub menu:



- View data** - Allows you to view the selected graph as a table. To return to the graph, right click on the table and select **View chart**.

Export > Export as an Image - Allows you to export the selected graph as an image so it can be downloaded and saved as required.

Export > Export to PDF - Allows you to export the selected graph as a PDF document.



Export > Export data - Allows you to export the contents of the selected graph into an Excel spreadsheet.
